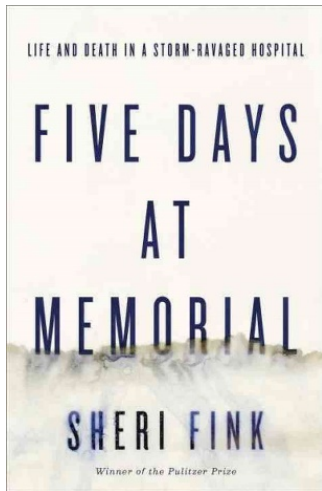


## 2021 Fall Education Days
